


Essential Medical Outreach & Treatment Rescue

EMOTER is a non-profit organisation registered in 2020 in Uganda. It is composed of young people with different medical academic backgrounds who are passionate and interested in addressing key issues which are: providing healthcare, health education, prevention/immunisation services, donations to the needy and sexual and reproductive health.

EMOTER has evolved from a group of enthusiasts into a humanitarian organization that helps improve living conditions in Uganda. **Our vision** is to bring free and accessible healthcare services because we believe that this should be a human right. **Our mission** is to bring lasting improvement in the lives of vulnerable people in Uganda.

OUR PROGRAMS

MEDICAL OUTREACH

Community medical outreach is about giving, contributing and helping those who cannot help themselves. It's something we call "jungle medicine" because we work in remote areas and we set up our "mobile hospital" close to where people live, at local community institutions such as markets, churches or libraries. Our team of volunteers reaches communities and provides them with doctor consultation, basic laboratory testing, prevention services and medication.

Our medical outreach services also provide volunteers with an opportunity to work first hand with experienced local doctors. Through this program, it allows us to influence younger generations to give back to the community.

PREVENTION

At EMOTER, we strongly believe prevention is the first step on a journey to better health.

In this program we target particularly those with risk factors for diseases and are treated in order to prevent a disease from occurring. That's why providing vaccines (HPV), vitamins, and deworming is a key part of our medical outreach program as well.

HEALTH EDUCATION PROJECT

Health Education is a new program that we are implementing effective this year, we employ different strategies of community engagement to ensure the information is accessible within the community.

Based on the target age group, we are preparing different educational programs for schools focused primarily on personal hygiene and selfcare awareness for the younger children and with a focus on reproductive health, STD prevention (HIV/AIDS and HPV awareness) and HPV immunization for older children and teenagers.

DONATIONS

Besides poor healthcare, people in these areas also have to face challenges ranging from poverty, hunger to lack of basic supplies.

Through our donation program we rally donors and organisations to help us reach such communities through providing food, hygiene products, clothing, fees/tuition sponsorship and school supplies.

OUR WORK

During **Community medical outreach** in **Nebbi** district (Pawong, Ayomo, Jupangira and Goli) in **March 2020** we provided healthcare and prevention services to **2693** patients.

OUR IMPACT



- During our medical outreaches we have treated a total of 3363 patients.
- Within the Prevention program we have applied 2346 vaccines, deworming tablets or vitamin A capsules.
- Currently we are a team of 15 enthusiasts from Czech republic and Uganda.

OUR VISION

The main goals of our program is sustainability and long-term meaning. We would like humanitarian aid to be followed-up with development aid in the future as well. We want all the people to have access not only to medical care but also to education. Together we would like to improve the standard of living in the long term.

Short-term goals

- Launch our e-shop during fall 2020.
- Launch a new educational program for schools in Uganda.
- Treat 20.000 people within the Medical outreach program in 2021.

Medium-term goals

- Set up an EMOTER branch office in Nebbi district.
- Establish a patient information system and provide needed long-term medication.
- Provide antenatal care and launch a preventive gynecological program.

Long-term goals

- Institute our own hospital and maternity-hospital.
- Continue our medical outreach program even in remote areas of Nebbi.
- Build up our own school for midwives and nurses.
